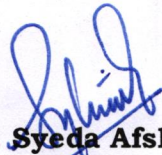

Please keep in mind the eligibility for Re-run MOOCs, as mentioned in the CEC letter, (attached herewith and already mailed to all).

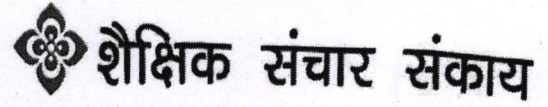

Subject: Submission of Proposed Courses for the January-June 2027 Semester – reg.

Sir/Madam,

This is with regards to the submission of List of Proposed Courses to MoE, for the upcoming semester. CEC has received the directions from the Ministry regarding submission of the Course for the Jan-June 2027 semester, for consideration and approval by the SWAYAM Board.

In this respect, all EMRCs are requested to submit the list of courses proposed to be offered during the January-June 2027 Semester by 28th August 2026. The proposed courses may be submitted only after ensuring compliance with the following requirements:

A. Eligibility of Institutions

1. Institutions ranked among the Top 100 in the NIRF Overall/Universities category and institutions ranked within the Top 50 in the relevant domain of the proposed course, namely Engineering, Management, Research, Pharmacy, Medical, Dental, Law, Architecture & Planning, Agriculture & Allied Sectors, and Innovation, may be considered for offering courses.
2. *Existing courses may be re-run*, however, it may be noted that not all 17 NIRF ranking categories will necessarily be applied for selection.

B. Re-run of Existing Courses

3. Existing courses may be considered for re-run subject to the following eligibility criteria:
 - Courses with more than 500 enrolments will be eligible for re-run.
 - Where enrolments are below 500, re-run will be permitted only if exam registrations are more than 25% of the total enrolments.
 - This condition shall apply uniformly, irrespective of whether the course is an employability, IKS or research-oriented course.
 - Courses having less than 500 enrolments and less than 25% exam registrations may be permitted for re-run without any financial benefits.
 - In exceptional cases, the SWAYAM Board may take a decision on permitting the re-run on the basis of a detailed justification submitted by EMRC.

4. While proposing existing courses for re-run, EMRCs are therefore requested to provide the relevant enrolment and examination registration data and clearly indicate the eligibility status of each course as per the above criteria.

C. Course Development and Submission Requirements

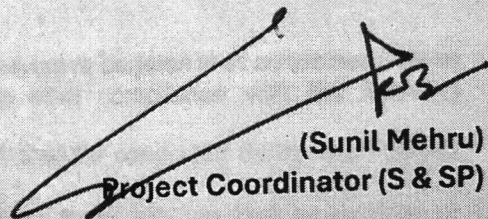
5. Full course details, including the Course Plan and Grading Policy, are required to be submitted in the prescribed format to CEC along with the proposed list (Formats enclosed).
6. All mandatory metadata fields, Course Plan and Grading Policy must be duly completed.
7. One faculty member should not handle more than one course as Course Coordinator at a time.
8. The EMRCs are requested to carefully assess each proposed course against the above requirements before forwarding the consolidated course list to CEC.

The Course List for the Jan-June 2027 Semester may kindly be submitted to CEC by 28th August 2026, positively ***in the given format only***, so that the consolidated proposal may be processed for consideration and approval by the SWAYAM Board.
